COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Betsy is a member of the Foster Care Review Board ("FCRB") in Maricopa County, Arizona, a citizens' review board created by the Arizona statute to advise Arizona's juvenile court system on progress toward achieving permanent, safe placements for children in foster care. Members of the FCRB are appointed by the Presiding Juvenile Court Judge in Maricopa County to serve three-year terms. Betsy has served as a member of the FCRB since her initial appointment in 2016, with reappointments in 2019 and 2021. Betsy has also served as a screening interviewer for the American Bar Association's Judicial Intern Opportunity Program ("JIOP") since 2009, repeatedly participating in the Phoenix JIOP annual orientations, and serving as a formal JIOP mentor from 2009 to 2014. Betsy also encourages her two children to take action in their community, most recently preparing hygiene and cleaning kits with her children to donate to the Welcome to America Project, an organization dedicated to assisting refugee families resettling in Arizona. Finally, time and permitting, Betsy enjoys volunteering at her children's elementary school in the Madison School District.
